To the APPLICANT:

The total cost per student to attend YTI is \$6,000. Through support from individuals, churches, and foundations, we are able to provide a partial-scholarship for every student (worth \$4,300). We ask all participants to pay a **\$100** non-refundable deposit. If you would like to request financial aid to assist with the remaining **\$1600** fee, please complete this application in its entirety. All questions must be answered. Financial aid is awarded on the basis of demonstrated need and availability of funds; financial aid applications have no bearing on the admissions process.

Follow these steps to complete your financial aid application:

- 1) Work with your parent(s) or guardian(s) to complete ALL of the information on the 2-page financial aid application provided.
- 2) Secure copies of your parents' or guardians' 2016 federal income tax returns AND 2016 W-2 forms.

Incomplete financial aid application will not be considered.
